

Departure from Belgrade at 09:00 h. First stop will be at the ethno village Maradik with opportunity to taste some of the domestic food products. After that, visit to Monastery Krušedol, one of the most beautiful monasteries at the Fruška Gora mountain. Monastery Church is dedicated to the Annunciation and it is rich painted. The oldest frescoes are from the first half of the 16th century. Arrival to Sremski Karlovci will be at 11:30 h. Sightseeing of the most important cultural and historical city's places of interest (Orthodox Cathedral, high school, seminary, Fountain Four Lions, Patriarch's Palace...) is organized. Also, visit to one of the wine cellars is planned where interesting story about wines and wine production can be heard and famous wines of Karlovci can be tasted (5 types). Follows departure to Krčedin village, where "Zekin salaš" located in the center of the village will be visited. It represents the restored old house of Srem region, where forgotten authentic dishes of this region are served. In 5,000 m² garden, the extension of "the second backyard," there is a place for rest and recreation (GreenZone), minizoo, playground and a large rabbit's maze. Lunch is organized with tamburitza music orchestra. Return to Belgrade around 19:00 h.
